THE HEART OF CUPS MISSION

CUPS Mission began with Christians confronting the exploitation of very young girls in the Dominican Republic. The organization developed a whole-family approach that combines Christian discipleship with counseling, nutrition, health care, education, and vocational training. The goal is not simply to meet an immediate need, but to help children and families build a sustainable future with dignity, skills, faith, and real choices.
